U.S. Cybersecurity

Ongoing serious cyber attacks on federal information systems and critical infrastructure are targeting our Nation's key operations and assets. Attacks are organized, disciplined, aggressive, and well resourced. Many are extremely sophisticated. Our talk will review current U.S. Cybersecurity efforts, a unified risk management framework, and new recommended security controls for Federal Information Systems and organizations.

David Hadley, CISA, CGEIT, is President of the David Hadley Corporation, a management consulting firm offering risk management solutions to the financial services industry. Prior, he was co-founder and CTO of a de novo Internet Federal Savings Bank. In this role David was an advisor to the inter-agency task force which authored the current Federal Financial Information Examination Council (FFIEC) IT Examination Handbook. David is active in the community where he is an adjunct graduate Professor of Information System Security for the Daverio School of Accountancy at the University of Akron; he is a member of the University Relations Committee of ISACA; and, he is on the board of the Association for Corporate Growth where he is chairman of the Technology Committee. David holds a masters degree in computer science from Illinois State University and an undergraduate degree in image and photographic science from Rochester Institute of Technology.

- Turn right onto Rockside Road at the end of the exit ramp
- Follow Rockside Road to Brecksville Road (Highway 21)
- Turn left on Brecksville Road.

- Proceed on Brecksville Road approximately 1 mile, Harry's Steakhouse is on the left side of the street.

From the East and West via I-480:

- Take I-480 to I-77 South
- Exit at Rockside Road
- Turn left onto Rockside Road at the end of the exit ramp
- Follow Rockside Road to Brecksville Road
- Turn left on Brecksville Road
- Proceed on Brecksville Road approximately 1 mile
- Harry's Steakhouse is on the left side of the street
